Welcome to Monkton Prep School. We are pleased and honoured once again to host the Rowland Jones Netball Tournament for U11 Girls. We do hope that you enjoy your afternoon here with us. Could we please ask that you park your mini bus at the top and walk down with your team.

Toilets are available in the Law building (please follow the signs along the paths). Light refreshments for coaches, parents and other adult spectators will be available from 2.00pm to 3.30pm in the Headmasters study, with match tea for girls as a takeaway snack from 4.00pm.

First aid is available courtside, with an RGN on standby in the main school building.



General information for players, spectators and coaches

- The tournament will operate as a 'waterfall' style tournament, so that all teams play the same amount of netball.
- Points will be scored as follows:
 - Win – 3 points
 - Draw – 1 point
 - Loss – 0 points
- In the event of two teams being level on points at the end of the Round Robin matches, final positions will be determined by the following methods:
 1. Goal difference
 2. Goals scored
 3. Result between the two teams
 4. Coin toss
- Where appropriate, in order to keep to time, please would the teams in each subsequent match be ready to come on immediately, having done the toss in advance.
- Please expect to umpire your own matches.
- Please wear clean shoes and stick to the paths when not on the courts.

Specific playing regulations

- Each squad should comprise of no more than ten players; please try to operate a half-game rule so that all girls get a good afternoon of netball.
- Players must have been U11 at midnight on 1/9/2019.
- Matches will be:
8 minutes each way (64 minutes total playing time); 1 minute half time, 3 minute changeover between games.
- Matches **will be centrally timed**, so do not start a round earlier than scheduled.
- Additional time can be allowed for serious injury only.
- Traditional 7-a-side U11 netball rules apply, not Bee Netball variations.
- In the event of a dispute, the final decision shall be taken by the tournament organiser.
