NOTES

1. Reception tuition fee reduced to £2,420 for pupils eligible for 15 hours of Early Years Funding (see below for eligibility). We offer a maximum of 15 hours Early Years Funding to pupils in Reception.

2. We offer up to 30 hours of Early Years Funding for eligible children attending Nursery. For further information please see the separate funding section below.
3. Tax-free Childcare Accounts or Childcare Vouchers can be used to pay for nursery fees and reception fees for terms that the child is eligible for Early Years Funding. They can also be used for holiday club and breakfast / after-school clubs for eligible children up to age 11.
4. Eligible Service personnel can apply for up to 20 hours per week of term-time wraparound childcare for 4-11-year-old children. For further information please see the separate funding section below.
5. A sibling discount of 5% will be applied to the tuition fees (Reception to Year 6) for the second child and 10% for the third and subsequent children whilst all siblings are at the school.



6. All discounts are applicable to the tuition fee element only, a full breakdown will be visible on the invoices.
7. School fees listed above include tuition costs, resources, lunch and personal accident insurance.
8. Trips and optional extras are charged separately.
9. School fees may be paid in advance, the pricing applied to any pre-paid fees would be based on the current published rates (for 2023/24) with a 3% annual increase applied to later years. Please see section below on VAT for more information.
10. A full term's notice is required before the removal of a pupil. In default of so doing, one term's fees in lieu of such notice will be charged.

CHILDCARE FUNDING INFORMATION

30 HOURS EARLY YEARS FUNDING

We offer up to 30 hours of Early Years Funding for eligible children attending Nursery. Please be aware that with the exception of certain criteria, funding cannot be moved between settings mid-term. This includes attending any funded sessions at an existing setting during the period between 1 January, 1 April or 1 September and the start of our respective term. Start dates should be arranged with the Registrar but consequently may be restricted to the start of academic terms for children in receipt of funding. Please be aware that moving to the area is a listed exception for which funding can be moved, and mid-term start dates may be considered, pending the availability of sessions. Please do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions or queries at all.

Please see below the timelines of when Early Years Funding (15 and 30 hours) first becomes available:

TAX FREE CHILDCARE AND CHILDCARE VOUCHERS

We could like to remind families that Tax-Free Childcare Accounts and Childcare Vouchers can be used to pay for holiday club and breakfast / after-school clubs for children up to age 11. This is in addition to nursery fees and reception fees for terms that the child is eligible for Early Years Funding. More information on Tax-Free childcare including eligibility is [here](#).

CHILDCARE FOR SERVICE CHILDREN

From Autumn 2022 eligible Service personnel can apply for up to 20 hours per week, term-time only of wraparound childcare for 4-11-year-old children. Further information, including eligibility can be found [here](#). This can be used for breakfast club and all after school clubs during term-time. Wraparound care will be invoiced in the normal way and should be paid by parents via their tax-free childcare accounts. PARENTS OF PUPILS CURRENTLY ELIGIBLE FOR CHILDCARE FUNDING

Please can all parents already claiming the additional funding and/or using Tax-Free Childcare accounts please remember to re-confirm eligibility via their Childcare account when prompted. This is required in order to continue claiming.



INFORMATION ON VAT

As you will all be aware the Labour Party have indicated an intention to introduce VAT on school fees if elected. No further details have been published at this stage – for example, we don't yet know at what rate VAT may be levied, from when, and whether all aspects of fees will be covered.

We know that this will be a real concern for many of you so we wanted to let you know what we are doing as an industry, as a group and within Heywood to challenge and mitigate this potential increase in the cost of school fees.

The professional bodies representing independent schools continue to lobby government and the Labour Party to highlight that the policy may actually end up costing the Treasury more than is raised through the tax if the policy were implemented.

We are reviewing our cost base to identify possible savings and also reviewing our current operating model. Heywood's senior leadership are working through numerous options from energy saving measures to class sizes, all aimed at minimising the level of fee increases that would result from this policy, or from growing financial pressures.

Within Wishford Schools Group we are considering how we may structure our charges to ensure that VAT is only chargeable where absolutely necessary and taking professional advice to ensure we are best prepared for this change.

An option that we feel important to highlight again is the opportunity to pay school fees in advance. We are advised that under current VAT regulations, a payment received prior to the new policy being introduced would crystallise the tax point and therefore would be treated as being exempt from VAT. This latest development makes the potential saving of this scheme, previously utilised to protect against inflationary fee increases, even greater. The pricing applied to any pre-paid fees would be based on the current published rates (for 2023/24) with a 3% annual increase applied to later years.
