Nursery children are asked to bring a spare set of clothes (these do not need to be branded uniform), socks and pants in a drawstring bag. These will remain on their peg for the whole term and used if needed.

Wellington boots should stay at nursery all term and will be sent home at the end of each term for parents to check sizing.

The nursery uniform becomes the children's PE kit once they move into Reception, so you might like to bear this in mind when selecting sizes if your child is in pre-school.

Winter uniform is compulsory from October half term until the end of the Spring Term. From September until October half term, pupils may wear either summer or winter uniform. Reception children all tend to start in winter uniform in September. Summer uniform is worn from the Easter holiday until the end of the Summer Term (or October half term).

Each item of uniform must be clearly named, sew-in name tapes are recommended.
